A high yielding, early season variety with round oval shaped potatoes. Friar has cream to light yellow skin and is a light yellow flesh coloured potato. The variety is well suited to dry baking, roasting, mashing and chipping markets with a great potato flavour. Friar is a relatively high dry matter variety.

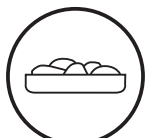
### Cooking Attributes
